



Who is Eligible?

Any resident who resides in Trent Hills, who is physically or functionally disabled. Temporary status is available.

Priority Level:

A-Client who is completely dependant on a wheelchair.

B-All other clients.

Priority order:

- 1). Healthcare appointments for priority A clients.
- 2). Healthcare appointments for priority B clients.
- 3). General bookings for Priority A clients
- 4). General bookings for Priority B clients

Booking for Appointments...

All reservations, especially for medical appointments, should be booked as soon as possible.

How to Make Reservations....

Call 653-1020 at least 48 hours prior to reserve your trip.

We will need to know....

1. Your name
2. Date & time of trip
3. Your destination
4. The purpose of your trip
5. Will anyone accompany you?
7. Are you bringing a scooter?
8. The size of your wheel chair

Call 653-1020 as early as possible, at least 24 hours in advance.

The van will only wait 5 minutes for pick-up. Therefore allow extra time if necessary.

What is the Fare?

*One way trip within Campbellford, Hastings and Warkworth is \$4.00

*All other trips within the catchment area are \$6.50, one way.

Attendants are free. Exact fare appreciated.

Out of catchment area trips and group trips can be arranged, fee will be determined by destination and # participating.

Care Giver Support and Respite Service

Provides support for the caregiver, to relieve stress placed on family relationships, through one on one visits and educational opportunities.

Friendly Visiting

Companionship in a group setting or one on one to share activities and conversation.

Home Help and Home Maintenance

Contracted workers provide assistance for routine household tasks and indoor and outdoor maintenance, repair work and meal preparation.

Telephone Security Checks

A short telephone call on a regular basis will provide a friendly voice, reassurance or send assistance when needed.

Wellness
