Building Permit Application Checklist

A building permit can be applied for in person or online on the <u>Trent Hills</u> Website.



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Before you apply for a building permit:

Check the zoning of the property by visiting trenthills.ca and fill in a Development Inquiry	Form
requesting the zoning of the property and permitted uses	

- Does your project require your <u>local conservation authority</u> approval and/or a permit? Contact them to be sure:
 - Lower Trent Conservation Authority at ltc.on.ca
 - o Crowe Valley Conservation Authority at crowevalley.com
 - o Otonabee Region Conservation at otonabeeconservation.com
- □ Is the entrance to the property registered and up to Municipal Standards? An Entrance Permit Application may be required

Building Permit Application Package must include:

Complete the "Application for a Permit to Construct or Demolish" including Schedule 1
Designer information. Indicate who will be taking responsibility for the project (your designer,
engineer, architect, BCIN holder).
If you plan to design your own home, as the property owner you can take responsibility
simply by writing "Homeowner Exemption" on the blank space following "basis for
exemption from registration and qualification" and sign/date "Designer Signature".
One set of building plans (minimum 11" x 17" in size).
A site plan of your property. Use the example on the Trent Hills website
If applicable, Tarion Warranty Corporation section filled out (Ontario New Home Warranty
Program.)
HVAC Documents submitted (HRAI Design and Ventilation Design Layouts). Heat loss and
gain.
EEDS Documents submitted (Energy Efficiency Design Summary Prescriptive and
Performance).
If you are not the property owner a Letter of Authorization from the property owner is required.
If a recent purchase, include a Deed or tax bill for proof of property ownership.
If the property is rural, a <u>Septic Permit Application</u> may be required to be submitted. If it is an
urban property, a water/sewer application is required.
ICF design details by qualified individual submitted.
